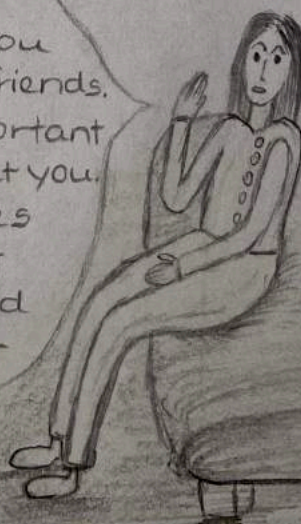


Lilly, listen please. I didn't want to blame you. We're all part of this system that exploits not only humans but also our earth.
